This bursary fund has been established by the CUPE PEI Division and affiliated participating locals.

TERMS OF BURSARY:

- (a) The value of the bursary will be a maximum of \$500.
- (b) The selection is to be made by the CUPE PEI Bursary Committee.
- (c) Application deadline post marked no later than August 31 of each year.

QUALIFICATIONS OF THE RECIPIENT:

- (a) The applicant must be a member in good standing of an affiliated and committed local to the Bursary Fund of the Division
- (b) The applicant must be the spouse, partner or dependant (adopted or natural) of a member in good standing of an affiliated and committed local to the Bursary Fund of the Division
- (c) The applicant must be enrolled in a Post Secondary Institution or Educational Institution and not limited to PEI institutions.
